## **Side Tilt Carriages**

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the fork carriage lifting capability, there are actually four sizes of hook type tine carriages. The hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing used for Class 1 is approximately thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry cargo up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold cargo as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type blades may be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades may vary by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the tine. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
